Eligibility

- **1**: Eligible Start–Up or Existing Business must apply through the **Access Accelerator**
- **2:** Age 18–65
- **3:** Financial Hardship will be considered for Eligibility
- 4: Valid business licence or started the business license process (proof required)

Overview

Disney Cruise Line has partnered with Access Accelerator to sponsor small business training, education, and grants for local businesses across a variety of industries, ranging from e-commerce and delivery services to tourism and construction. Both new and existing businesses are eligible to receive small business grants.

The maximum grant funding available to each entrepreneur will be **\$5,000**.

The application opens **May 10, 2021,** and closes **June 4, 2021.** Classes will be available to create an executive and financial summary including marketing, accounting, and overall business strategy.






