










Academy WOMEN ENTREPRENEURS

During this programme, participants are able to build their business plan on the Dream builder platform and gain knowledge from speakers in various industries every week on topics such as marketing and funding your dream. At the end of the programme, participants will have a completed business plan and get the opportunity to pitch their business in a competition & possibly receive seed funding.











OVERVIEW







The winners of the Pitch Competition will be awarded \$5,000 in grant funding to assist with the scaling of their business.
















THE PROCESS


- 1. Interested participants for Cohort 4 must submit their application forms, along with required documents through the online application form on our website at https://zfrmz.com/jm1PaEVR60iqbp6XRIrm. After submission, applicants will receive an email notification on the status of their application in December 2023.
- 2. The top applicants will be shortlisted and sent an email notification that they've been selected to partake in the programme.
- 3. Applicants that are not selected to partake in the programme will be notified via email communications and invited to apply for other existing programmes or future programmes.












THE PROCESS CTD.

- 4. For the selected cohort of participants, after their successful participation in the training course and pitch competition, the top ventures per cohort will be awarded funding. Grant proceeds will be dispersed based on vendor invoices and wire instructions received, as well as, internal policies and procedures.
- 5. Access Accelerator will publish the names of successful applicants and the amount of approved funding. Applicants are required to participate in public relations initiatives which may include but are not limited to newspaper features, social media stories and radio appearances. Applicants are also required to provide economic impact data to Access Accelerator for three years post-approval date.




